## A Dictionary of your Mentoring Sessions

What is onomatopoeia? Find out! Each of you seek out to find new and interesting English words and share them at your next session. Make your own book of definitions that continues to grow as your mentee grows. When you find a new word, think of all the ways it has been used in the past, how it is used now, and ways that each of you may use it in a sentence. If it is a thing, consider having a scavenger hunt and see who can “spy” it first! If it is an adjective, see who can use it first in a sentence and record it when you do. Making words and definitions fun will make reading less scary and more interactive, improving both your mentee’s self esteem and your vocabulary!
